

“Training and research in economics and management” week

Call for papers for Masters students

Context

To strengthen the links between training and research, the Graduate School Economics & Management (GS E&M) organizes the second edition of ***the “training and research in economics and management” week*** dedicated to the Phd/doctoral and master's students.

The event will take place on **October 11 and 12, 2023** at the Jean Monnet Faculty in Sceaux (RER Robinson). It will be followed by the GS E&M general assembly on **October 13**. The exact program will be announced at a later date, but the event will consist in the following.

- Workshops/roundtables, plenary lectures and presentations from research units within the GS E&M perimeter, as well as the “Law, Economics, Management” (Droit, Economie, Management – DEM) doctoral school, will be organized to present all facets of research.
- Students and PhD candidates will have the opportunity to present their own work (internship, dissertation, tutored project, doctoral thesis, etc.) and discuss their areas of interest with specialists, whether members of GS E&M or invited (foreign) experts.

This call for presentations is open to Master's students (M1 or M2).

The best presentation will be selected by the GS E&M: two prizes of €500 each for the students - winners of the papers based on work carried out in the Economics and Management master's programs.

Procedures and terms of application

The "SFREM" call for presentations from Master's students is open to all students enrolled in Masters 1 or 2 for the year 2023-2024 (including students at the end of Master's 2, 2022-2023), in one of the GS E&M Masters programs. Students are invited to communicate (alone or in groups) on a research project, internship or university essay. The format is a 10-minute oral presentation. fundamental or applied research, conducted (or in progress) as part of a tutored project, an internship or a dissertation. Submissions will be examined by a committee selected from the GS E&M Council. This committee will also appoint the awards jury, which reserves the right not to award a prize.

Submissions may be addressed to gs.economics-management@universite-paris-saclay.fr reine.bou-fadel@universite-paris-saclay.fr and noemie.moutty@universite-paris-saclay.fr with the heading **"Communication SFREM - Etudiant en Master" (SFREM communication - Master's student)**. They should take the form of a pdf document, 2 pages maximum, mentioning the surname and first name of the candidate, the discipline, the master's degree (level, M1/M2) and the institution of registration, the tutor(s)/supervisor(s), the context of the work (internship, dissertation...), in addition to a long summary of the proposed contribution. Submissions may be submitted in French and/or English.

The **deadline for submissions** is **September 23, 2023**.
