As there is an **accommodation shortage** in the region, it is important to **be proactive** and to **start looking** for housing at least **two months prior to your arrival. Not so fun fact:** A 20sqm studio costs between 600€ and 800€ in Orsay and between 800€ and 1,000€ in Paris.
