# Doctoral studies at Université Paris-Saclay in figures

- 4339 doctoral students, i.e. 7% of all doctoral students in France, supervised by some 2500 thesis directors and over 3000 co-supervisors, more than half of whom are researchers.
- 94,6% paid to prepare their thesis
- 275 laboratories
- 13,000 publications per year, 13% of French research
- 18 Graduate Schools and Institutes
- 21 Doctoral Schools
- 1 Maison du Doctorat

# Maison du doctorat - Background

- ✓ The Maison du Doctorat is the administrative department that implements the strategic orientations of the doctoral schools and the University's governance. It provides operational support to the research vice-president in charge of doctoral policy.
- ✓ The Maison du Doctorat is a department operating at the level of the 14 establishments of the Université Paris-Saclay and serve all of them.
- ✓ The administrative management of the doctoral community (doctoral students, thesis directors, research units, doctoral schools, Graduate School) is based on a single, shared information system, ADUM.

# **Responsible for the operational implementation of doctoral training policy**

- Guarantee a framework of common practices
- Develop the international attractiveness of the Université Paris-Saclay's doctoral program
- Ensure the promotion and visibility of the Université Paris-Saclay's doctoral program
- Produce various indicators

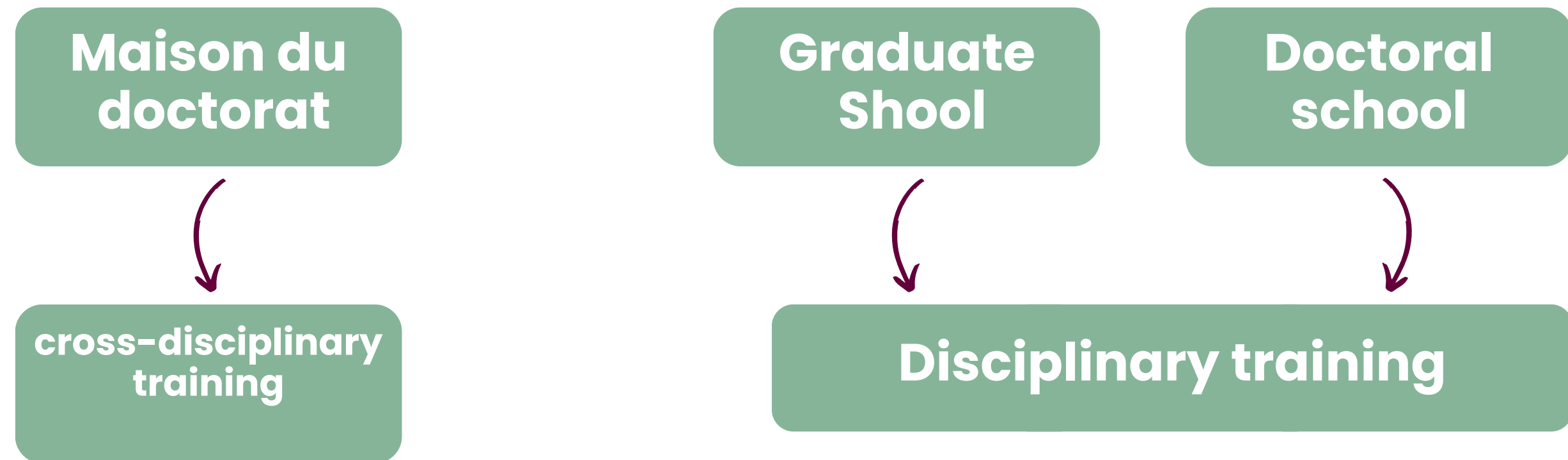

# What is cross-disciplinary training?

Cross-disciplinary training is training that is open to all doctoral students, whatever their scientific discipline. Unlike disciplinary training, which is specific to a particular field, cross-disciplinary training covers skills and knowledge that are useful and applicable to all researchers, regardless of their specialty



## **Some examples of cross-disciplinary training programs at Paris-Saclay:**

- Science communication and writing scientific articles
- Thesis writing support
- Professional mobility and preparation for life after the PhD
  
- Research ethics and scientific integrity
- Sustainable development
- Research data management and open science
- Prevention of psychosocial risks and combatting discrimination, gender-based violence, and sexual harassment
