Selection process:

Candidates for the international scholarship program of Université Paris-Saclay will be selected by the admission panel of Université Paris-Saclay master's program.

Only those students contacted by the master's program admissions panel are authorized to complete an application form.

No unsolicited application is allowed.

Application for the scholarship program:

Step 1 :

Selected students automatically receive by email a link to the online application form they must fill in.

Step 2 :

Upon receipt of this email, the student has 8 days to complete and validate the application form and to provide the names of two referents.

Step 3 :

The two referents provided by the candidate each receive an email with a link to an online recommendation form. They have 8 days to complete and validate this form online.

The candidate is automatically informed when each form has been validated.

It is the candidate's responsibility to make sure each referent has validated the recommendation forms on time.

Step 4 :

The file is considered complete when the two recommendation forms have been validated.

Important: the candidate will not receive a message stipulating that his file is complete.

Step 5

The final decision is the responsibility of a panel of experts of Université Paris-Saclay.

The candidates admitted into the scholarship program will be informed by email 48 hours after the meeting of the jury.

When the student receives the confirmation email, he/she will have 8 days to accept or refuse the scholarship. If the student fails to respond within this timeframe, he/she will be considered as having refused the scholarship.

Questions / answers

I received an admission letter to the master's program. Does this mean that I have also been awarded a scholarship?

No, being admitted into a master's program of Université Paris-Saclay does not automatically entitle you to a scholarship.

Only the students selected by the master's program admissions panel of Université Paris-Saclay can complete the online application form for a scholarship.

The winners of the scholarship program will be informed by email 48 hours after the meeting of the jury.

How do I know if I am selected for the scholarship program?

You will receive an email informing you that you have been selected.

I have been selected during the first wave. If I do not respond within the allotted timeframe, will my application still be valid for the second wave?

No.

If I am not contacted, can I still apply for a scholarship?

No, **unsolicited applications are not accepted.**

I have been accepted in M1 and I have been invited to apply for a scholarship.

Will I also receive the scholarship the following year in M2?

No, the scholarship is granted for one year.

My studies include a period of time studying in another establishment other than the one where I am registered (example exchange program). Will I continue to receive my scholarship during this period?

No, the scholarship will be suspended and cannot be deferred for the amount of time spent in another establishment in France or abroad.

Can I cumulate the Université Paris-Saclay scholarship with another scholarship?

Yes but the amount of this second scholarship must not exceed 600€ per month.

I applied to several master's programs of Université Paris-Saclay and I received several automatic messages inviting me to apply for a scholarship. Can I complete several online applications?

If you are accepted in several master's programs **of Université Paris-Saclay**, your file may be selected several times. You can, therefore, submit several application forms.

If you obtain a scholarship for several masters, you must choose one of them.

I completed my online application form for a scholarship. One of my two referents does not respond. Does this pose a problem?

Yes, your file has to include two recommendations. Otherwise it will be ineligible.

I completed my online application for a scholarship. One of my two referents does not respond. Can I give the contact information of another referent?

No, this is not possible.

How do I know if my application is complete?

Your application will be complete when the two referents have completed and validated their recommendation form. You will automatically receive a message after each validation.

It is your responsibility to make sure they fill in the form before the deadline.

You will not receive any message informing you that your application is complete.

I missed the deadline to fill in my application form. Is there anything I can do to remedy this?

No, no further appeal is possible.

How can I find out what was decided in terms of awarding scholarships?

Winners will be informed by email 48 hours after the meeting of the jury. Once you receive a message that you have been awarded a scholarship, you will have 8 days to accept or refuse the scholarship. If you do not respond within this timeframe, you will be considered as having refused the scholarship.

I am on the waiting list, when will be informed of the scholarship attribution?

Waiting list candidates will be informed by email when other students refuse their scholarships.

Be aware, refusals can be expressed late.

Can a scholarship awarded for one master's program be transferred to another master's program?

No, the scholarship is only valid for the master's program you have been admitted to.

Will I receive my scholarship before I leave for France?

No, you will receive the first installment of your scholarship approximately six weeks after your arrival in France. You should provide enough money to pay for your housing fees, administration fees, health insurance...

Which establishment will pay the scholarship?

The establishment you are registered in is responsible for paying your scholarship.

If I am awarded a scholarship, do I have to pay the registration fees?

Yes. The scholarship does not cover the registration fees nor any administration fees linked to entering or living in France. Nor does it cover health and insurance fees.
