Information note for candidates in the 2MIB competition

The MESRI 2020 competition of the ED 2MIB aims to distribute the 22 to 23 doctoral contracts given by the establishments of Université Paris-Saclay, operators of the ED 2MIB.

The ED policy is part of the policy and procedures proposed by the Paris-Saclay doctoral college. The aim of the competition is to select the best candidates for doctoral contracts. This selection is made on criteria of excellence based on the study of an academic record and an interview of the candidate.

You will have 10 minutes to present your curriculum vitae, your research experience and the thesis project established in agreement with the host team. This presentation will be followed by a discussion with the jury. The total duration of the interview is limited to 15 minutes.

Given the health conditions linked to the Covid 19 crisis, all the interviews will be carried out by videoconference.

The videoconferencing platform used will be Collaborate.

For the interview, you must first make sure you have a working computer equipment: connection, camera and microphone.

Training rooms are already open, you can go there to test your equipment.

The link for the jury room will be sent to you later.

Your **slideshow in pdf format** must be sent to dir_2MIB@universite-paris-saclay.fr, 48 hours before the time of your interview.

For the interview, you will have to place yourself in the conditions of a face-to-face interview, **alone and in a dedicated room**. Provide a board, slate or notepad large enough to possibly write your answers to the jury's questions and show them to the camera.

You must connect at least 10 minutes before the time of your call.

When you log in, you will enter the main competition hall (or waiting room), wait. You will be welcomed and your identity will be verified, have **your ID** handy. You will then be taken to the jury room. Your slideshow will already be loaded. The president of the jury will give you the floor. You can start your presentation. You will be able to control the passage of your slides. During the questions, the members of the jury will turn on their camera.

At the end of the interview, you will have to exit the session.

The results of the competition will be published on June 4.
